Sealed bids will be received by the City of Walnut Grove for furnishing all materials, labor, tools, equipment, and any other miscellaneous items necessary for the Emerald Drive Storm Sewer Rehabilitation project.

Bids should be submitted to Walnut Grove City Clerk no later than 2:00 P.M. on Thursday, August 26, 2021. Submit bids via email to <u>cityclerk@cityofwalnutgrove.com</u> or deliver to Walnut Grove City Hall, 2581 Leone Avenue, Loganville, GA 30052. Any bids received after said time and date will not be considered by the City of Walnut Grove. Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at this time and location. All bids will be evaluated by the City of Walnut Grove and the project will be awarded, if it is awarded, within 45 days of the bid opening.

Copies of documents and plans can be obtain on the Georgia Procurement Registry website.

The successful contractor must provide proof of workers compensation and liability insurance with the City of Walnut Grove named as additional insured. The City of Walnut Grove reserves the right to waive any informalities or to reject any or all bids, and to accept any Bid which in its opinion may be in the best interest of the City.

A Contractor Affidavit verifying compliance with the Federal Work Authorization Program known as E-Verify must be submitted with each bid. This form must be notarized.

CONTRACTORS and SUBCONTRACTORS will be required to comply with all Federal, State, and local laws.

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Project Description: The project involves the rehabilitation of approximately 70 linear feet (LF) of existing 54-inch diameter corrugated metal pipe (CMP) storm sewer crossing under Emerald Drive in the Emerald Cove subdivision in the City of Walnut Grove, Georgia. The rehabilitation will include sliplining a new 48-inch diameter steel reinforced corrugated polyethylene (SRPE) pipe into the existing storm pipe. The Contractor shall provide all labor, equipment, materials and any other miscellaneous items necessary for the project in accordance with the Scope of Work and Exhibit 1.

Scope of Work

 <u>Traffic Control</u>: The Contractor shall be responsible for all traffic control activities required during the performance of the Work. The Contractor shall submit a work sequence schedule to the City of Walnut Grove for review and approval no less than two weeks prior to beginning construction. The Contractor's fee shall include notification signage or portable traffic message boards to be placed on each approach to the job site informing motorists of any approved road closure at least seven days in advance. Contractor shall provide all necessary traffic control devices, signage, and barricades as required by MUTCD standards. <u>No full closure of Emerald Drive will be permitted.</u>

The City prefers that any partial closure of Emerald Drive be limited to one lane closure for not more than two days and the work conducted on weekdays from 8 am-5 pm, if possible. The road is the only means of ingress/egress for more than 50 residences in the Emerald Cove subdivision .

- 2. The Contractor shall coordinate with local utility agencies to ensure protection of all utilities in the project area.
- 3. The Contractor shall provide and maintain equipment needed to bypass creek flows away from the project area, as needed, during the performance of the work.
- 4. Contractor shall provide erosion and sediment control throughout the duration of the project in accordance with GSWCC BMP's.
- 5. Contractor shall limit clearing of vegetation in the project area to only those areas needed for access of equipment and materials and installation activities.
- 6. Contractor shall thoroughly clean the existing storm pipe of all dirt and debris and dispose of all waste materials off-site at a facility permitted to accept such materials.
- 7. Contractor shall install new 48-inch diameter SRPE equal to Contech Durromax pipe or approved equal. Pipe shall be installed so as to maintain a constant downward grade throughout the storm drain from the upstream end to the downstream end. The new pipe shall be set flush with the exterior facing of each of the upstream and downstream headwalls. Provide jacks or similar spacers between the new and existing piping in accordance with SRPE manufacturer recommendations, as needed, to maintain pipe slope and to prevent floating of the pipe during installation of grout. Grout the annular space between the new and existing piping. Provide witness ports to ensure that the annular space is filled across the entire span of pipe.
- 8. Contractor shall grout the existing upstream and downstream headwall and apron to seal the pipe annular space and match the elevation of the new inlet invert elevation.
- 9. Contractor shall regrade and install riprap at the upstream and downstream ends, as needed, for stabilization of the channel bottom after installation of the new piping is completed. Riprap shall be installed to match the existing channel invert elevations.

<u>Project Management/Inspections</u>: Project management and inspection will be provided by the City of Walnut Grove and/or Precision Planning, Inc.

<u>Schedule</u>: All work shall be completed in 14 days.

Safety: Contractor shall be responsible for jobsite safety, and the safety of the traveling and general public within the work zone.

<u>Access</u>: Contractor shall be responsible for coordinating access to private property during the execution of the work.

Measurement and Payment

<u>Creek Bypass and Flow Management</u>: The basis of payment for this item shall be lump sum to include all labor, materials, fuel, equipment and other miscellaneous costs associated with the installation and operation of facilities needed to divert flows in the creek away or through from the project area during the duration of the Work, including sediment and erosion control.

<u>Cleaning Existing Storm Pipe</u>: The basis of payment for this item shall be lump sum to include all labor, materials, fuel, equipment and other miscellaneous costs associated with cleaning the existing storm piping and the removal and disposal of waste materials.

<u>Pipe Installation</u>: The basis of payment for this item shall be per linear foot of new SRPE piping installed via sliplining and shall include all labor, equipment and materials required for the installation of the new piping, including grouting of the annular space and grouting of the upstream headwall apron.

<u>Channel Stabilization</u>: The basis of payment for this item shall be per horizontal square yard of riprap placed to include all labor, equipment and materials required for the installation of all required riprap.

<u>Traffic Control</u>: The basis of payment for this item shall be lump sum to include all labor, equipment and materials associated with traffic control activities.

No separate measurement or payment will be made for site preparation, earthwork, erosion and sediment control, coordination with property owners, protection of existing utilities and site restoration. Payment for these items shall be included in the unit price bid per linear foot of pipe installed.
